Get ready to vote in the **General Election**

- Firstly you need to register to vote online HERE
- You will be asked for your National Insurance number (but you can still register if you do not have one) and may be asked for your passport details.
 - 🖸 You need to provide the address you were last registered to vote at or failing that the last address in the UK you lived at.



Register to Vote online

Apply for a Postal Vote

- Once your registration is confirmed by your local
- If you live in a place close to the UK with a very good postal system and with a speedy and reliable service with the UK then:-
- You can apply for a postal vote HERE

Your ballot will be posted to you soon after they are printed for any Election.

OR

- If you live in a place far from the UK with an uncertain postal system with no reliable service with the UK then:-
- You should apply for a proxy vote HERE
- You must nominate and trust someone else to vote the way you want for you.



Your proxy does not need to live close to your registered address in the UK and can instead choose to cast your proxy by post - this is called a postal proxy.
