Get ready to vote in the General Election

1

- Firstly you need to register to vote online [HERE](#)
- You will be asked for your National Insurance number (but you can still register if you do not have one) and may be asked for your passport details.
- You need to provide the address you were last registered to vote at or failing that the last address in the UK you lived at.

- Once your registration is confirmed by your local electoral team then:-
- If you live in a place close to the UK with a very good postal system and with a speedy and reliable service with the UK then:-
- You can apply for a postal vote [HERE](#)
- Your ballot will be posted to you soon after they are printed for any Election.



 Apply for a Postal Vote

OR

- If you live in a place far from the UK with an uncertain postal system with no reliable service with the UK then:-
- You should apply for a proxy vote [HERE](#)
- You must nominate and trust someone else to vote the way you want for you.



 Apply for a Proxy Vote

- Your proxy does not need to live close to your registered address in the UK and can instead choose to cast your proxy by post - this is called a postal proxy.
